Feud	Cause, Effect, and Resolution
Aphrodite vs. Athena vs. Hera	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Cause: A golden apple o Effect: The Trojan War was started o Resolution: Aphrodite won the apple but lost the war
Apollo vs. Hermes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Cause: Cattle theft o Effect: Apollo hunted Hermes down o Resolution: Hermes smoothed things over with a gift after Zeus intervened
Apollo vs. Poseidon	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Cause: Both gods wanted to marry Hestia o Resolution: Hestia declared a vow of eternal chastity
Apollo vs. Zeus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Cause: Zeus killed Apollo's son with a lightning bolt o Effect: Apollo killed the makers of the lightning bolt o Resolution: Apollo served a mortal
Ares vs. Hephaestus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Cause: Both men loved Hephaestus' wife o Effect: Hephaestus trapped his wife and Ares in a net o Resolution: Ares paid a fine to Hephaestus
Ares vs. Poseidon	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Cause: Poseidon's son attacked Ares' daughter o Effect: Ares killed Poseidon's son o Resolution: The first ever murder trial and Areopagus are established
Athena vs. Poseidon	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Cause: Both Olympians wanted to be patrons of Athens o Effect: Both Olympians showed off their powers o Resolution: Athena won
Athena vs. Poseidon	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Cause: Odysseus, one of Athena's favorite mortals, killed Poseidon's son o Effect: Poseidon kept Odysseus from home for 10 years o Resolution: Athena eventually helped Odysseus return home
Demeter vs. Hades	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Cause: Hades kidnapped Demeter's daughter o Effect: Demeter caused a famine o Resolution: The seasons are established and Demeter's daughter splits her time with Demeter and Hades
Demeter vs. Poseidon	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Cause: Poseidon tried to assault Demeter as a stallion o Effect: Demeter caused a famine o Resolution: Demeter purified herself in a river
Dionysus vs. Hera	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Cause: Dionysus' mother had an affair with Hera's husband o Effect: Hera drove Dionysus mad o Resolution: Dionysus saved Hera from her golden throne
Hephaestus vs. Hera	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Cause: Hera was ashamed Hephaestus was crippled o Effect: Hera threw Hephaestus from Olympus o Resolution: Hephaestus trapped Hera in her golden throne
Hephaestus vs. Zeus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Cause: Hephaestus tried to defend Hera o Effect: Zeus threw Hephaestus from Olympus o Resolution: Hephaestus recuperated on an island
Hera vs. Poseidon	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Cause: Both Olympians wanted to be patrons of Argos o Effect: Hera won o Resolution: Poseidon dried up the rivers
Hera v. Apollo and Artemis	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Cause: Apollo and Artemis were Zeus' children by another goddess o Effect: Hera tried to prevent their birth o Resolution: Poseidon or Artemis (born first) led the goddess to a safe island to give birth
Hera vs. Zeus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Cause: Zeus' many, many affairs o Effect: Hera persecuted Zeus' children and mistresses

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">o Resolution: Sometimes Hera wins, sometimes Zeus suspends Hera from Olympus
Zeus vs. Athena, Hera and Poseidon	<ul style="list-style-type: none">o Cause: Athena, Hera, and Poseidon wanted to replace Zeuso Effect: Zeus is imprisoned in chainso Resolution: Thetis sent a hundred-handed helper to free Zeus
Ultimate Showdown: The Trojan War	<ul style="list-style-type: none">o Aphrodite vs. Athena and Herao Artemis vs. Herao Athena (through Diomedes) vs. Aphrodite and Areso Ares vs. Zeuso Hera vs. Zeus
