- [5] **Ares v. Poseidon:** *P.'s son Halirrhothius attack A.'s daughter Alcippe, trial, Areopagus*
- [6] **Athena v. Poseidon:** *Patrons of Athens, competition of powers*
- [7] **Athena v. Poseidon:** *Odysseus & Polyphemus, 10-year voyage*
- [8] **Demeter v. Hades:** *Persephone, famine, seasons*
- [9] **Demeter v. Poseidon:** *Stallion disguise, famine, Offspring Arion & Despoina*
- [10] **Dionysus v. Hera:** *Semele's affair, madness, sacrifice (; include Ino and Athamas)*
- [11] **Hephaestus v. Hera:** *Shame re. crippled, thrown from Olympus, Thetis, throne revenge*
- [12] **Hephaestus v. Zeus:** *Defending Hera, thrown from Olympus, Lemnos & Sintians*
- [13] **Hera v. Poseidon:** *Patrons of Argos, dried-up river beds*
- [14] **Hera v. Apollo and Artemis:** *Zeus' infidelity with Leto, prevent birth, Delos*
- [15] **Hera v. Zeus:** *Zeus' affairs with many women, persecution (Hercules, Dionysus)*
- [16] **Zeus v. Athena, Hera and Poseidon:** *Rebellion, Zeus in chains, Thetis & Briareus (hekatoncheires)*

Zeus:</b> <i>Greeks v. Trojans, use of Aphrodite's golden belt to stop Thetis' request</i></p> <p>[21] <b>Apollo v. Athena:</b> <i>Chryseis (plague) and death of Achilles, Odysseus and Trojan Horse</i></p> |
