Verb Stems

Present Stem: take “-re” off of 2nd principal part

Perfect Stem: take “-ī” off of 3rd principal part

Personal Endings

Present Tense:
(simple present) -o -mus
 (“is/are” verbing) -s -tis
 -t -nt

Imperfect Tense:
 (“was/were” verbing) -m -mus
 (“used to” verb) -s -tis
 (“began to” verb) -t -nt
 (“kept on” verbing)

Future Tense:
 (“will” verb) 1st/2nd Conjugations
 -bo -bimus
 -bis -bitis
 -bit -bunt

Perfect Tense:
(simple past) -i -imus
 (“did” + verb) -isti -istis
 (“have/has” verbed) -it -erunt

Pluperfect Tense:
 (“had” verbed) -eram -eramus
 -eras -eratis
 -erat -erant

Future Perfect Tense:
 (“will have” verbed) -ero -erimus
 -eris -eritis
 -erit -erint
